Vehicle Speed

- The speed limit on all the neighborhood roads is 25 mph.
 Please be mindful of your speed.
- Please slow down when approaching the gates. Watch out for people performing gate maintenance or repairs.
 Higher vehicle speeds also put greater stress on the bottom gate track which increases the potential for the gates to become dislodged especially during high winds.

Leasing Amendment

An amendment to the RCR Community Covenant and Restrictions (CCR) document is up for a Community vote. 192 YES votes are needed to pass it. The current vote tally is 103 YES and 26 NO. 89 more YES votes are need for it to pass. This initiative is important if you have concerns with short-term rentals being allowed (example, Airbnb) in the neighborhood. Questions to consider include the following:

- Do you support having a continuous stream of visitors accessing the neighborhood who are not familiar with Community guidelines and do not have a long-term interest in RCR?
- Do you have safety concerns?
- Do you have concerns regarding your property values?

A checklist for January:

PESTS

 Check junipers and other narrow-leaf evergreens for bagworm pouches where eggs lay overwinter. Remove by hand.

PRUNING

Prune peach and plum trees to maintain a spreading growth habit and an open center.

PLANTING

- Order seeds.
- Plant fruit trees, grapes, blackberry canes, asparagus, snap peas and onions.

MISCELLANEOUS

- Transplant established shrubs and trees while dormant.
- Make 'the right plant in the right place 'your New Year's resolution. Begin your garden and landscape plans now.
